STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

South Plains College has identified goals and outcomes for student achievement which are aligned with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's (THECB) strategic plan 60x30TX . 60x30TX (http://www.60x30tx.com/) is comprised of student-centered goals. These goals include completing credentials, gaining marketable skills, and limiting student debt. These goals are stated below.

- **Educated Population-** By 2030, at least 60 percent of Texans age 25-34 will have a certificate or degree.
- Completion- By 2030, at least 550,000 students in that year will complete a certificate, associate, bachelor's or master's from an institution of higher education in Texas.
- Marketable skills- By 2030, all graduates from Texas public institutions of higher education will have completed programs with identified marketable skills.
- **Student debt-** By 2030, undergraduate student loan debt will not exceed 60 percent of first-year wages for graduates of Texas public institutions.

Based on these goals we have developed institutional goals that we feel are achievable and important benchmarks for South Plains College to meet. SPC had three divisions that contribute to the total number of certificates and degrees. The three divisions in which we offer programs of study are Arts and Sciences, Health Occupations and Technical Education.

REGIONAL TARGETS

As Part of the 60x30TX Plan the state of Texas has set up regions with regional targets to help Texas public institutions achieve the 60x30TX goals. The THECB used data on regional populations, migration, enrollment, and completion patterns to identify three targets for each region.

- A regional target for the 60x30TX education population goal
- A Regional target for the completion goal
- A regional target for the target under the completion goal that aims for 65% of public high school graduates to enroll directly in higher education by 2030.

The state has identified 10 regions. South Plains College is in the High Plains Region. The state of Texas has set regional goals for these 10 regions. The college's student achievement targets were set with these regional goals as a key component.

Institutional Goals:

1. South Plains College will reach a 56% 6-year graduation rate as reported by the THECB by the year 2030.
